

Website rules:

1. What types of items can be published on the website?

Items that support the mission statement (the vision) of the dioceses.

2 How do I know that what I want to contribute/have published meets the criteria?

The mission statement is being interpreted broadly in the light of Bishop Nazir Ali's statement "Every movement of the People of God, every communal expression of the Body, is Church. Movements in the Church, whether local, national or international which have as their aim the furtherance of the Gospel can also be Church".

Events that are not regarded as supporting the "bricks and mortar" of the church meet the criteria. This includes fund raising events which are in support of a "mission" activity. General news items relating to parishes will not be published on the website, with the exception of special services.

Details of visits from overseas mission partners, mission agencies, clergy and various "mission" related activities will be published.

Close-up photos of children will not be published.

3 How do I go about having an item published?

(a) If you are not sure of whether your item meets the criteria, send brief details to the mailbox doitnow@witness.ie . You will receive a prompt response.

(b) If you are confident that your item meets the criteria:

- a. Send the item and any relevant photographs to the mailbox;
- b. Explaining briefly how it satisfies the criteria, and providing dates for publication (if these are relevant)
- c. You will receive confirmation within a couple of days.
- d. You may be asked to edit or change some of the material submitted.

4. Any item may be removed by the Council at any time (and a reason given).
